



KOKKINOVRACHOS (RED ROCK) 2013

Type: Dry red wine – PGI Peloponnese

Variety: 50% cabernet sauvignon – 50% merlot

Region: half-mountainous vineyards of the estate in Leontio

Soil: clay

Microclimate: Mediterranean

Harvest: cabernet sauvignon : 10/09 - merlot: 28/08

Alcohol : 15% **Residual Sugars :** 2.2 gr/lt **Total Acidity:** 5.4 gr/lt (tartaric)

Vinification: typical red fermentation in stainless steel tanks, maceration for 12 days and malolactic fermentation in the tanks. Maturation for 24 months in French oak barrels and at least 6 months in the bottle.

Characteristics: concentrated flavors of ripe fruits with hints of marmalade, smoke and chocolate that gives a deep red color and distinguished tannins.

Serving suggestions: game, stews, red meat, fat yellow cheeses
